## **Takefumi Hori Statement**

"My practice is based around various inspirations and artistic endeavors. I am not trying to create works that tell viewers how to think or feel. I make subtle suggestions, which allow people to engage on a level that is beyond just the visual.

I work in several distinct series, but the Circle pieces could be described as the core of my oeuvre. The circle holds rich associations, both in Eastern and Western traditions. I choose not to give specific titles to my paintings. Instead I simply number them, which allows each to communicate their own inner meaning.

Collectors describe my Circle paintings using words such as esoteric, calm, relaxing, beautiful, and pure. They have also been characterized as contemplative, yet arresting. I intend for them to be more than simply abstract depictions of shape and color, but rather invitations to consider form, material, and metaphor.

Ultimately my paintings are intended to provide a space for the eye to wander and the mind to rest."
